ABOUT THE RE-RELEASE: This was one of the first tunes that we recorded in Nashville and has been one of our best sellers and one of our most popular tunes for a long time. The original Square Dance recording, with a vocal by Ingvar Pettersson, has been unavailable for many years. This new version, a complete digital re-mix, features a dynamic new vocal by Tony Oxendine, whose close colleague, Jerry Story, was actually in the studio, with us, in 1989 – when the music was first recorded

Where, When and Who produced the music:

In 1989, we began recording in Nashville. We are indebted to Jerry Story and Tony Oxendine who introduced us to the studio in Nashville and invited us to use the top-of-the-line professional session musicians that they had assembled, to play for Royal Records.

This was part of that First group of releases on Sting that were recorded in Nashville. A total of four songs were recorded during this session, which was produced jointly by Stefan Sidholm and Ingvar Pettersson.

The music featured the top session musicians in Nashville. These included:

Gregg Galbraith – who acts as band leader - on guitars, Terry McMillan on Harmonica and percussion, Doug Jernigan on Steel and Dobro, Jerry Kroon on Drums, Roger Morris on Piano and keyboards with Rob Hojacos on fiddle, David Smith on Bass Guitar and Bruce Watkins on Rhythm Guitar / Banjo / Mandolin. Also worthy of special mention is our engineer on these sessions – also the studio owner – Kevin McManus.
