Neil Diamond is an American singer-songwriter whose career began in the 1960s, to date he has sold over 125 million records worldwide, making him one of the most best-selling artists of all time. He is the third most successful adult contemporary artist on the Billboard charts behind Barbra Streisand and Elton John. His songs have been covered internationally by many performers from various musical genres. An outstanding and accomplished showman whose name is synonymous with success!

There is a lot happening on this track and we tried to do what we could to include everything and feature it, in some way, on our recording. Obviously, if you are familiar with the original, you will find ir fairly easy to use but be careful, some of the phrasing is outside of the "normal" structure for a Singing Call. The final effect is great, it is a "head-turner", as soon as the music begins to play, dancers recognise the track and start to pick up the rhythm and instrumentation; they are "dancing" before they move!

Music: the where, when and who...

The music for this release was created in Texas, at the Studio used for Global Music Productions, by producer emeritus: Doug Bennett.

Doug made it possible for Paul Bristow to work with the studio on a "remote" basis. All the Musical arrangements are prepared in the UK - we specify the instrumentation that we would like, as well as the rhythmic feel to be used - and rely upon Mike McLean, the Studio Engineer in Texas, to act as the "on-site" producer for these tracks.

Sting Productions Ambassador Club:

This was the second session to have been underwritten by the members of the Sting Productions Ambassador Club; a group of Callers who worked together to choose the tunes and who contributed, financially, to the costs of producing and distributing the music.
